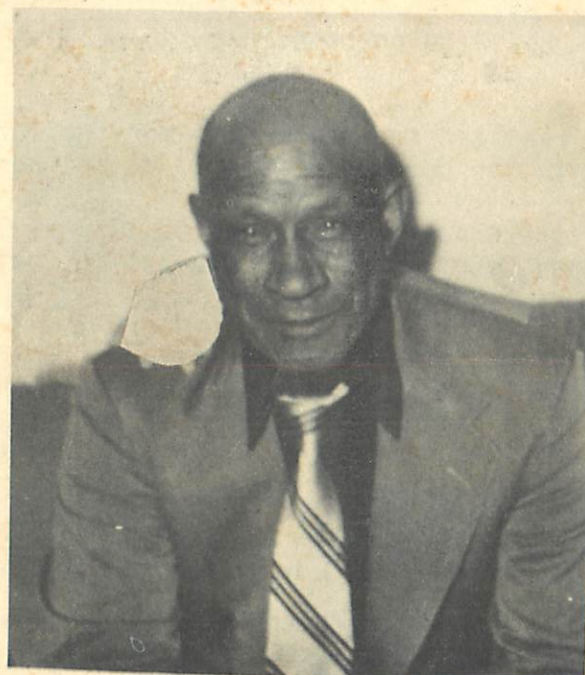

He passed to eternal life on June 4, 1978 at 5:30 p. m. at the Tipton County Memorial Hospital in Covington, Tennessee.

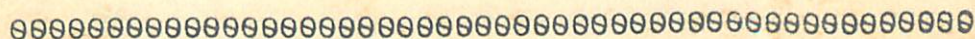

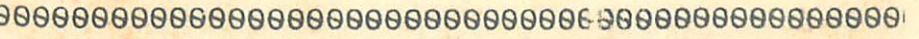
