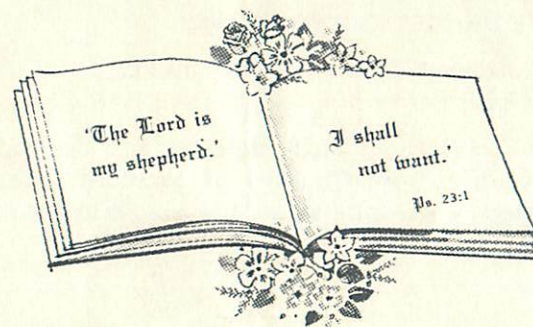
Perhaps you sent a lovely card,
